Call for Student Submissions – JACLaS International Award

- Open to students at university, technical schools and community colleges, and students in Biomedical Laboratory Sciences. (Students must be enrolled in a relevant institution as of October 2025)
- Any topic relevant to basic and clinical research in Biomedical Laboratory Sciences.
- In the application form, fill in the name of the presentation, name of the presenter, affiliated school, or college, and three keywords.
- The abstract can be of any length up to 1,800 characters in total. Over 1,800 characters are impossible to register.
- Submit the form by email* to the JACLaS Office e-mail by 31st March 2025.

- The JCLS Program Committee will select 3 winners at maximum, and the winners only will be contacted.
- Each student will make the presentation during the Student Award Presentation period on Saturday, October 4th.

Winners will receive

1. All expenses for hotel, and transportation from home to venue, up to ¥200,000.
2. Conference fee paid by JCLS
3. An invitation to the General Assembly for the Awards Ceremony
4. Award Certificate, Award Plaque, ¥10,000 Cash Prize
